



PRAYER POINTS *from May 2 & 4, 2023*

“For where two or three gather together as my followers, I am there among them.” - Matthew 18:20

In light of National Day of Prayer last week, our prayer assignment this week is the following:

- We agree with this prayer from Pastor Terri Copeland Pearsons, prayed on last Thursday’s broadcast, thanking God for His plan for the USA and for working through His people:

“Father, we are so thankful and so grateful for Your wisdom, for Your graciousness, and for Your great plan. You had a great plan for the United States of America, and it is not over! We thank You, Lord, that this nation was founded in a covenant with our founding fathers—a covenant Lord, to You; a covenant founded in the covenant of Abraham and in the covenant with our Lord Jesus Christ. That is a threefold cord that is not easily broken. We remind You of that, and we are reminded of that.

How thankful we are in the name of Jesus...that we are Your instruments and Your tools for Your good plan and for Your purpose for this nation, for the Body of Christ and people around the world.
