



NY/PA Jewish Voter Poll

Key findings:

The Jewish vote appears to have moved 19 points relative to President Joe Biden's 2020 national performance in key New York congressional swing seats. In New York, Democratic presidential nominee Kamala Harris is winning 56%, down from 68% in 2020 for Joe Biden.

- The shift is even more dramatic in Pennsylvania, where our polling shows that the Jewish vote has moved 31 points relative to the 2020 national performance among Jewish voters.

- The Jewish vote also appears to have moved 15 points relative to the 2020 national performance in terms of the generic congressional vote in key NY congressional swing seats.

- The terrorist attacks on October 7th and the rise of antisemitism across the world is causing Jewish voters to become more politically engaged and turning out in large numbers on primary and election day.
 - 66% report being more likely to vote in the aftermath of Oct 7th.
 - 67% report being more likely to vote given the rise of antisemitism.
 - 75% believe that the outcome of the November elections is very important.
